### **Nursery Admissions Closing**

Admission to our Nursery Class is co-ordinated by the School. Parents are asked to apply online.

Once the online system closes we will offer places to children using the Hertfordshire criteria. We will continue to offer places in criteria order until all places are accepted. We will then allocate morning sessions according to our Nursery Admissions Policy. We are unable to offer 30 hours Nursery provision currently and will continue to offer just 15 hours over 5 days.

The online application system for September 2017 opened on Monday 6th February 2017 and closes today, Friday 17th March 2017. Offers will be available to view online on Tuesday 25th April 2017.

This will be for children born between 1st September 2013 and 31st August 2014.
