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Pupil Premium Allocation Foundation Stage Summer Term 2015

The Pupil Premium was introduced in April 2011 and is allocated to schools to work with pupils who have been registered for free school meals at any point in the last six years (known as 'Ever 6 FSM') and Children Looked After. The allocation for 2014 is £ 1300 per eligible pupil. In addition there is a new Early Years Pupil Premium amounting to £303 per pupil for children below school age.

Learning Behaviour		
Speaking and Listening Games 'Communication and Language Support'	£105	Children are better able to learn and have higher self-esteem and motivation. They will make quicker progress. ST indicator + 6 months
Games to develop social skills 'Social and Emotional Aspects of Learning'	£105	Children will develop positive learning behaviours and will develop better reading and maths skills ST indicator +7 months
Nurture Group Activities to improve interaction with peers and adults.	£105	Children will develop positive learning behaviours, improved attainment, attendance and progress. ST indicator + 3months

Number recognition, counting objects/actions Maths Booster	£105	Accelerated progress for PP children in maths and problem solving reducing the gap with non-PP. The gap will be narrowed between PP and their peers. ST indicator + 5 - +8 months
Literacy Skills		
More Able and Talented (MAT) Phonics + Additional phonics to support a desire to read and develop confidence.	£105	Children will maintain good attainment and progress in line with their non-PP peers. ST indicator + 4months
Phonics Booster Small group additional phonics to over-learn and secure phonics phases.	£105	Children will make better progress in their reading and writing. Reduce the gap between non-PP and PP children. ST indicator - + 4 months
Fine Motor Skills Group To develop hand strength and control of implements to form recognisable symbols.	£105	Children are able to record their ideas and do not become frustrated and/or refuse to participate in writing and recording activities. ST indicator - + 2 months
Reading Booster To develop children's fluency through blending and extra opportunity to practice reading at school.	£105	Children will be more confident at reading and will make progress in line with their non-PPG peers. ST indicator - + 4 months
