Children will use finger spaces between words.
Children will write for a purpose.

Children will use props to act events in information books and stories.
Children will recognise graphemes and know the sounds they represent.
Children will join in with rhyming activities.
Children will continue a rhyming a string.
Children will recognise HFW and 'Tricky' words.

Maths

Children will recognise numerals to 20 and order them.
Children will form numerals correctly.
Children will know 1 more and 1 less.
Children will recognise missing numbers.
Children will add and subtract.
Children will solve problems.
Children will double, halve and share.
Children will know names and properties of 2D shapes and 3D shapes.
Children will use vocabulary related to time, distance, money, capacity and length.

Children will combine different media for a purpose.
