

Communication and Language Development

Read books – don't forget non-fiction if you have these at home

Play games – Simon Says and I spy are wonderful for listening and understanding

www.pobble365.com – talk about a picture every day

Wordplay – find new words in a book and talk about what they might mean. Don't forget to re-read the sentence and check illustrations for clues.

CBeebies – Andy's sound adventures encourage listening

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Choose an illustration from a book - talk about feelings of characters when reading stories

When have you felt? game - use a range of emotions in game. Can you show that emotion using your face?

Board games – take turns, share and listen to the rules

Physical Development

Busy Fingers activities (e.g. playdough – dough disco, threading, cheerios on spaghetti, cutting, drawing, squeezing sponges or flannels)

Squiggle While you Wiggle – up, down, side to side, over humps, under humps, circles, zigzags

Time challenge – how many jumps, hops, star jumps etc. can you do in 1 minute?

Go noodle – lots of dances here

Healthy / unhealthy – design a healthy meal, sort items from the kitchen

Literacy Development

Sounds already learnt to recap:

Consonant digraphs: ch, sh, th, ng

Vowel digraphs and trigraphs: ai, ee, igh, oa, oo, ar, or, ur, ow, oi, ear, air, ure, er.

Geraldine the Giraffe – youtube

Jolly phonics actions – youtube

Rhymes for letters – see sheet

Phonics play – pick a picture, Buried Treasure,

Reading – anything you have at home. Try to include non-fiction if you have them. Tell your adult about the story

Listen to a story – Cbeebies or storyonline.net have a range of stories

Active learning – Squiggle (see PD), Boom shake the alphabet, tricky word songs for phase 2 and 3

Writing – instructions for cleaning teeth, sorry letter from Goldilocks to the Three Bears, shopping list for Little Red Riding Hood

Letter formation – remember to start on the line, write CVC words and use within a sentence

Alphablocks – choose an episode and join in with the blending

Mathematical Development

Shapes – explore your house for 2d and 3d shapes

Topmarks – practise your counting, sorting, pattern making, number recognition

Money – what coins can you find around the house? Order them. Set up a shop and buy things

Time – practise telling the time for o'clock and half past. What time is lunchtime / dinnertime? What time do you go to bed?

Higher or lower – use a pack of cards, choose 5 and place them down. Will the next card be higher or lower than the current card?

Numberblocks – choose an episode

One more / one less – ask your adult to give you a number. What is one more / one less?

+ / - sentences – write your own and check the answers using pictures and resources

Expressive Arts and Design

Make a prop for the Role Play or Small World – our next topic is Over and Under the Sea

BBC School Radio – choose a song / nursery rhyme using the A-Z page

Junk modelling – what can you make using empty boxes, cartons? Use Kiddle to make sure you have all the features

Construction – can you build a new house for the three little pigs?

Dance – find your favourite tune and free style

What's the weather? – check every day and make a note

Floating and sinking – choose things from around the house and predict whether they will float or sink before checking
