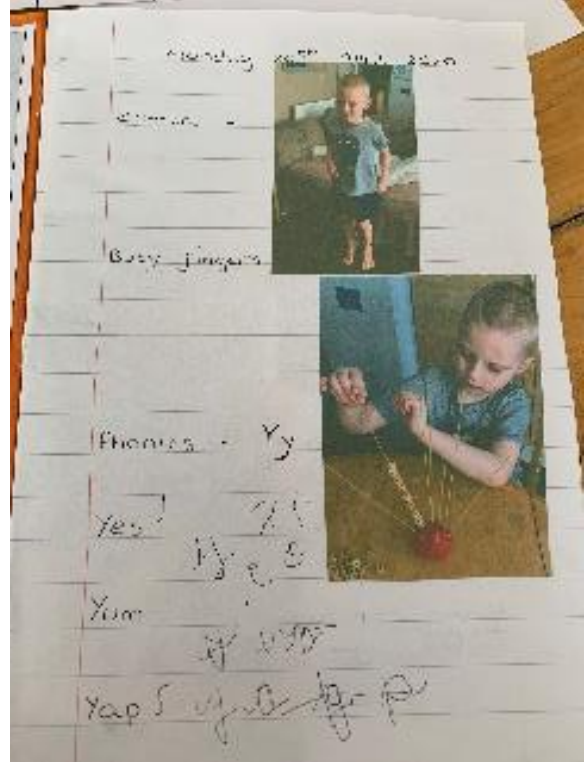
Transition

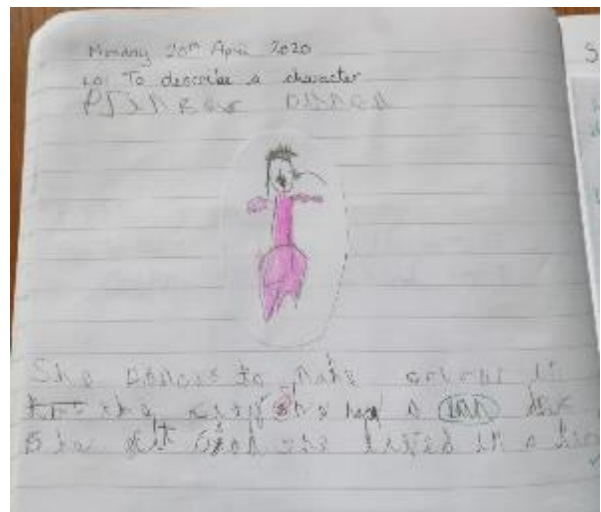
In the meantime, please be assured we will support all children with the transition process whether schools remain closed or not. It would be helpful if you ensure your children focus on this academic year's learning at the moment.

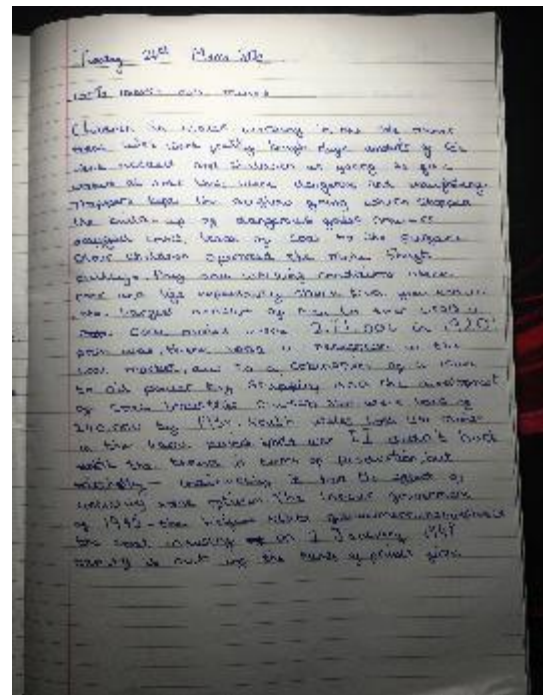

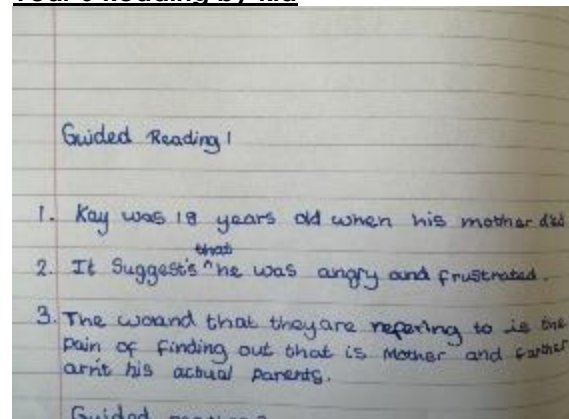
